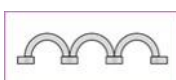

### Christmas Services in the Benefice

We can all expect a very different Christmas this year as the country continues in its efforts to defeat the spread of Coronavirus. The requirement to be socially distanced means that far fewer people can be seated at services than in previous years.

Assuming we are able to have a congregation present at all, we are afraid that we must operate a booking system for all services on 24th December (Children's Crib Service and Midnight Mass) and for the mid-morning Christmas services to provide a safe experience and to manage expectations fairly and transparently. There can therefore be no entrance without a booking 'on the day'.

Places can be booked by household for each service via the Benefice website using Eventbrite and government guidance will be applied.

All bookings will open on Sunday 29 November 2020.
